BIO

Gildo Medina, born in Mexico City in 1980, is a visual artist whose work reflects a rich tapestry of cultural and social influences garnered from over two decades of living and working in major art capitals, including Paris, Madrid, Rome, Florence, and New York. His art critically examines the human condition, employing a visual language that defies simple categorization and resonates with the complexities of contemporary society.

Medina's academic journey is both extensive and diverse. He honed his skills in drawing and painting at esteemed institutions such as the art academies in Florence and the San Carlos Academy in Mexico. He holds degrees in Design from the Universidad Iberoamericana and in Fashion Advertising from the Universidad Jannette Klein in Mexico City. Furthering his studies, he pursued Photography, Multimedia, and Art Direction at Central Saint Martins in London and earned a Master's Degree in Cultural Management from the Istituto Europeo di Design in Rome.

Throughout his career, Medina has received over thirty awards across various disciplines, underscoring his technical prowess and artistic versatility. His work has been featured in esteemed art publications by Assouline, Gestalten, and Taschen. Notably, Senior Editor Julius Wiedemann included Medina in "Portraits" and twice in "The Illustrator: 100 Best from around the World," positioning him among the most significant contemporary portraitists and illustrators globally.

Medina's art has been exhibited in prominent museums, galleries, and art fairs worldwide, including the International Contemporary Art Fair (FIAC), Maison et Objet, the Cultural Institute of Mexico in Paris, Casa de América in Madrid, Pinta Fair in Miami and London, Design District in Dubai, MACO, and the Museum of Modern Art in Mexico City.

His distinctive style and technical excellence have attracted collaborations with ambassadors, aristocrats, curators, musicians, writers, and other notable figures, who have sought to be immortalized through his art. Medina's versatility is evident in his ability to work across various mediums, from traditional drawings on paper and canvas to painting on special editions of luxury accessories and antique French furniture.

Currently based in New York, Medina continues to develop his artistic practice, engaging in projects with cultural institutions and luxury brands. His works are part of significant private collections in cities such as New York, Los Angeles, Miami, Mexico City, Paris, Florence, Berlin, Brussels, Madrid, London, Monte Carlo, São Paulo, Tehran, Dubai, Hong Kong, Shanghai, Tokyo, and Sydney.



Historically, portraits functioned as tools for self-promotion and alliance-building, exemplified by Anne of Cleves, whose marriage to Henry VIII was annulled after he found her portrait misleading. In today's digital era, dating apps have transformed this practice, with users curating profiles to express their identities and desires.

Medina's series features classical academic drawings paired with words or phrases written in reverse, requiring a mirror to read them. This approach invites viewers to reflect on the duality between self-perception and external presentation, emphasizing the relationship between personal identity and societal expectations.

By merging traditional artistic techniques with modern themes, Brief Love Stories provides a nuanced commentary on the shifting nature of desire, identity, and connection in the digital age.

By choosing those most important to him during the past several years, LOVE, STRENGTH, FORGIVENESS, HOPE, PEACE, JOY, DESIRE, LIGHT, DREAMS, GRATITUDE, FREEDOM, among others, Medina invites those who observe this work to experience the mystical energy projected by the message that inspired each one.

Throughout history, human eyes have been important motifs in the art and mythology of most cultures. They reflect intelligence and spirit, and they are considered magical, protective symbols and the "window to the soul." Since the beginning of his artistic career, Gildo Medina has been captivated by human eyes and they've always been one of the most characteristic and powerful elements in his work. Medina's passion for painting eyes has always been instinctive; he is captivated by the beauty, magic, and strength they express. JUST SEX

n this male erotic series, Medina visually captures memories, fantasies, and desires inspired by the complex beauty of sex in hypersexualized contemporary societies, where "more is more" and the idea of experiencing sex (and sometimes love) is "never enough." Today, all that is needed or desired is immediately accessible with a few taps on a screen ; thousands of years of evolution of the art of seduction have been reduced to basic demographics that describe us or what intrigues us in just a few "key words": age, role, size, interests, or "Pics?" This series is neither a documentary nor a critique. The imagery and text in these works generate sensory experiences capable of triggering a variety of reactions: pleasure, confusion, excitement, indifference, disgust, and fascination. It might well be a diary, a chronicle, or simply a fantasy.

Medina's intention for these works was to blur the line that separates eroticism from pornography in the same way a thin line separates the simply delightful from the sublime experience of orgasm.

In "Just Sex," Medina integrates classical styles, contemporary execution, and atypical formats and techniques in realistic works, such as "invisible drawings" with inkless pens, and often with text written in the languages in which the artist's mind and heart are most often expressed. He is fascinated by the contrast between the erotic and the vulgar, the subtle and the grotesque, the beloved and the loveless, the frivolous and the sublime. In these works, Medina reimagines himself as an artist without prejudice or frustration, not with the intention of simply creating erotic art, but of creating living art where we, as both human being and voyeur, find convergence with our own desires.

NEO-PORTRAITS

After having studied classical painting for several years in Mexico and Italy, and while living in Paris, more than ten years ago, Gildo Medina began to explore portraiting differently; he coined the term "neoportrait", to describe his own way of decontextualizing the classical way in which portraits are typically created and understood. In "neo-portraits", Medina experiments with unique media, formats and materials, e.g., this exploration has included such things as the back of a mutilated antique chair, a tree trunk or pages in a sketchbook covered in gold leaf, a travel trunk, a leather canvas. Medina chooses each of these elements and materials with precise intention based on their particular characteristics and suitability for the creation of visual metaphors as an important part of storytelling in his portraits.

In neo-portraits, Medina recollects stories, often autobiographical, and expresses his concerns, fascinations, and obsessions through the different characters that inhabit his visual narrative. In this series, Medina questions traditional concepts of beauty, eroticism, and reality, building through confrontation, a renewed conception of his own identity.

VARIATIONS

Medina uses variations to give new life – and often new meaning – to an existing work; with modification or "intervention," these pieces capture "l'air du temps," the essence of the moment that are metaphors captured in the language of art. They are created with experimental, but specific intentions to alter the original work in a way that changes its narrative and reflects Medina's evolution as artist and a human being. These pieces are most often fine art giclée editions printed on cotton paper or leather modified by the addition, suppression, mutilation, or removal of specific elements, such as motifs, metaphors, or text that may be formal, playful, or irreverent. Medina's approach to creating different variations of the same original work gives collectors the opportunity to know and appreciate how he has modified the artwork they collect in other, complementary or contradictory ways.
